**The Stirling Council (B8033 and Sunnyside, Dunblane) (Temporary Closure) Order 2017  
B8033 / Sunnyside, Dunblane**

The COUNCIL made The Stirling Council (B8033 and Sunnyside, Dunblane) (Temporary Closure) Order 2017 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) on 22-9-17.

The ORDER will close:-

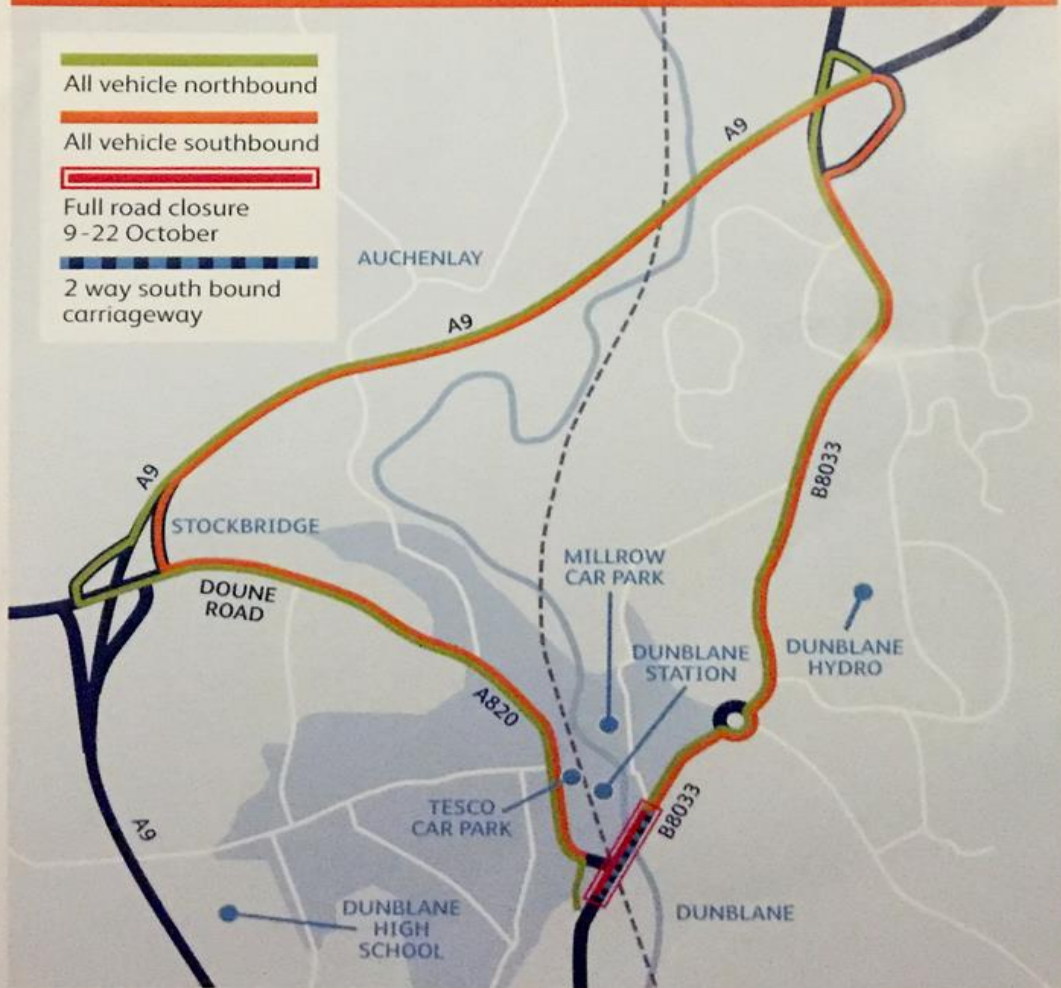
B8033, Dunblane The northbound section of the B8033 from the roundabout at Sunnyside, Dunblane Claredon Place to the junction of Stirling Road and the southbound section of the B8033 from the junction of Beech Road to the roundabout at Claredon Place. Sunnyside will also be closed for its entire length. All roads closed from 9-10-17 until 23-10-17 to ensure public safety during bridge works.

Alternative Route: via Claredon Place-Springfield Road-Doune Road-A820-A9-B8033-Perth Road and vice versa. NB: Claredon Place will be open to two-way traffic.

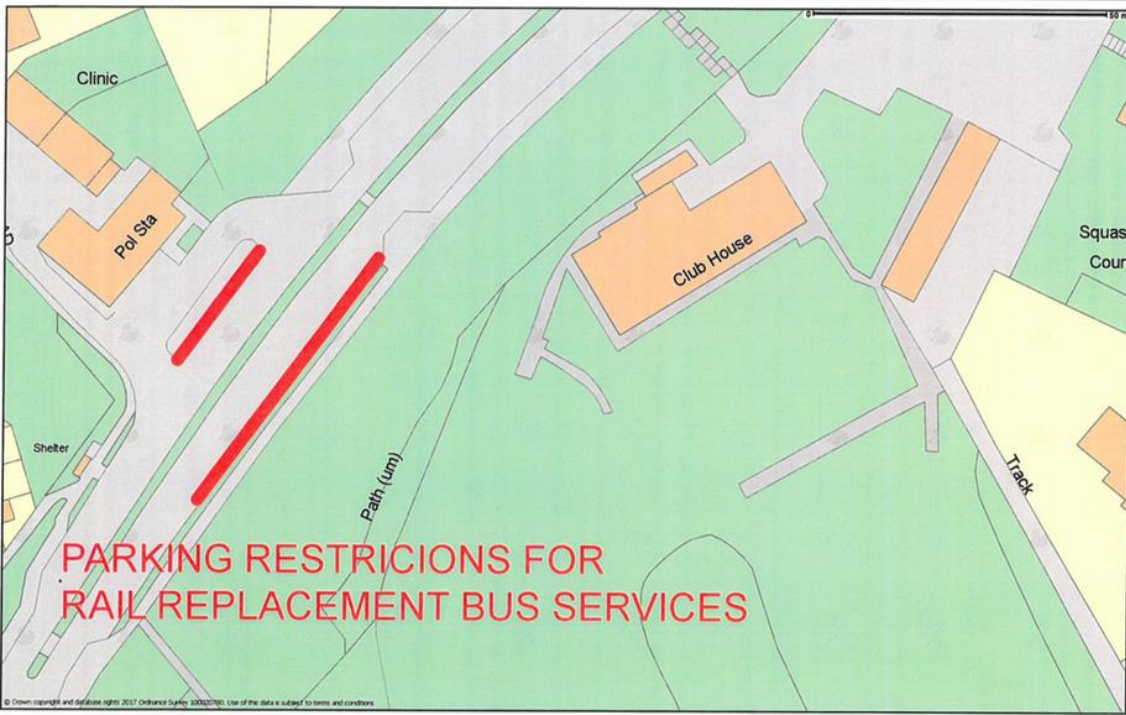
# PARKING

Parking is available at the following locations: -

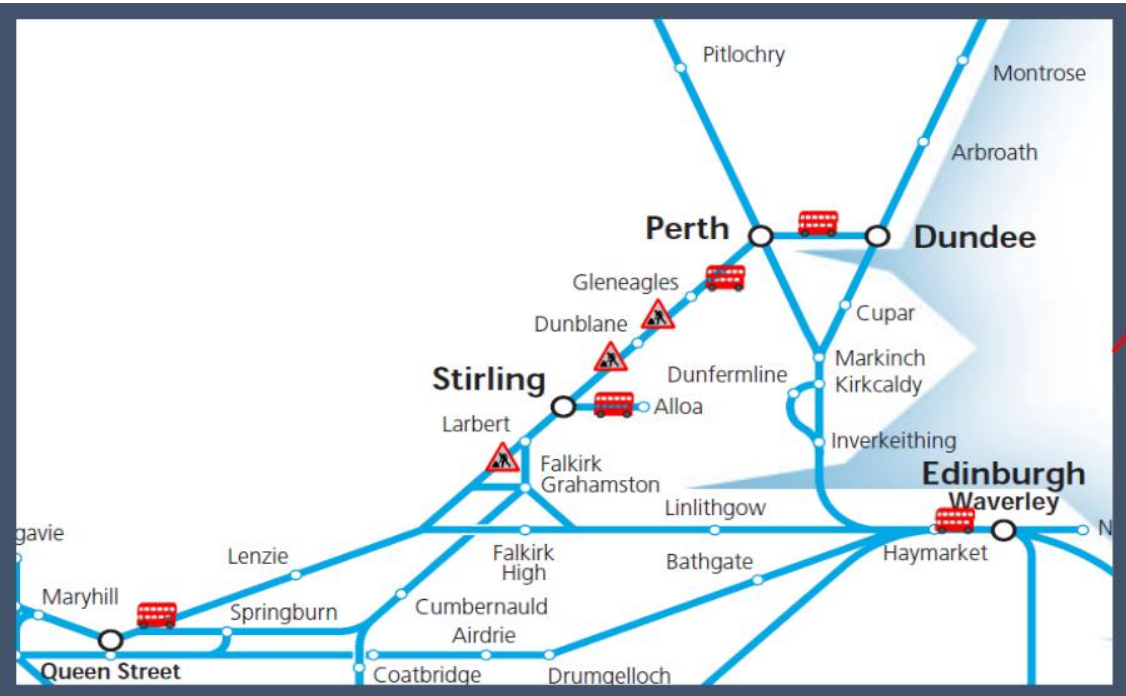

**RAIL LINE CLOSURE**



**INFORMATION FROM NATIONAL RAIL**

Network Rail are carrying out engineering work in the Stirling area, **closing all lines**. No trains will operate in the area on Saturday 14 and Sunday 15 October.

A reduced train service between Glasgow Queen Street and Aberdeen /

Inverness will operate via Fife. Buses will replace trains between Glasgow Queen Street and Perth / Dundee via Stirling.

### **ScotRail**

Trains between Glasgow Queen Street and Falkirk Grahamston are cancelled. Customers should use trains between Glasgow Queen Street Low Level and Cumbernauld, a replacement bus service will operate between these stations.

Trains between Glasgow Queen Street / Edinburgh and Stirling / Alloa / Dunblane, an hourly service will operate between Glasgow Queen Street and Edinburgh. A replacement bus service will run between Polmont for stations to / Dunblane / Stirling, replacement buses will operate between Croy and Alloa.

### **Virgin Trains East Coast**

Trains to / from Inverness will be diverted between Haymarket and Perth. A replacement bus will run between Edinburgh, Falkirk, Stirling, Gleneagles and Perth (as well as Dunblane southbound on Sunday).
